

Turkey Import Regulation Changes

Changes in Turkish Import Regulations Affecting Delivery

Summary

Due to changes in the import regulations into Turkey, Yubico is suspending all YubiKey as a Service Delivery shipments to Turkey immediately. White Glove enterprise shipment services and Yubico online store shipments are not affected.

Details

Recently, the Turkish government abolished the €30 low-value simplified customs threshold. All individual imports, regardless of value, are now subject to full customs duties and taxes. Turkey's standard 30% Import VAT continues to apply to all shipments for the EU, 60% elsewhere. Providing the recipient's Tax ID remains mandatory.

In addition, the Simplified Customs Declaration system for express couriers has been eliminated. Major global carriers such as DHL, FedEx, and UPS are no longer permitted to automatically clear small packages on behalf of individual recipients.

Instead, the carrier will contact the recipient to arrange customs clearance and collect a local customs brokerage fee, which typically ranges from \$30 to over \$100 depending on the carrier and shipment. Packages will be held in a bonded warehouse until clearance is completed.

Due to this change, **all automated and FIDO pre-registration shipments to Turkey are suspended until further notice.** White Glove service is still available as an alternative. Shipments to Turkey will be disabled in the Customer Portal on **June 19, 2026**. If you have any questions, please contact your Yubico representative.
