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ORDERING FIPS-VALIDATED YUBIKEYS

As of May 26, 2026, the YubiKey 5 FIPS Series with firmware 5.7.4 has achieved FIPS 140-3 validation. Review the information in this chapter for guidance on purchasing both the latest YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-3 Series keys as well as the prior YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-2 Series keys.

1.1 YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-2 Series availability

At present, the prior YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-2 Series keys are still available for purchase.

For enterprise customers with FIPS inventory who order through the Customer Portal or YubiEnterprise API, YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-2 Series keys can still to be ordered via the following product IDs and product names:

54	YubiKey 5 NFC FIPS
55	YubiKey 5C NFC FIPS
56	YubiKey 5Ci FIPS
57	YubiKey 5 Nano FIPS
58	YubiKey 5C FIPS
59	YubiKey 5C Nano FIPS

Important: In the future, the “FIPS 140-2” identifier will be appended to these product names to distinguish them from the new FIPS 140-3 keys. **If you create shipments via API and you use the `product_name` field to add products to the `shipment_items` array, we recommend transitioning to the use of the `product_id` field to proactively reduce any potential disruptions caused by the product name changes.**

1.2 Ordering the latest FIPS 140-3 validated keys

FIPS 140-3 validated YubiKeys are now available for purchase for both enterprise and non-enterprise customers.

For enterprise customers with FIPS inventory who order through the Customer Portal or YubiEnterprise API, YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-3 Series keys can be ordered via the following **new** product IDs and product names:

Important: FIPS 140-3 validated keys and FIPS 140-2 validated keys have distinct product IDs. If you create shipments via API and you wish to order the new FIPS 140-3 validated keys instead of the older FIPS 140-2 validated keys, make sure to update your code to use the new product IDs from this table.

PIV ATTESTATION WITH THE YUBIKEY 5 FIPS 140-3 SERIES

New intermediate certificates were created in October 2025, and YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-3 Series keys will make use of these new certificates in addition to the existing intermediate certificates. Therefore, to successfully perform PIV attestation with all YubiKey 5 FIPS 140-3 Series keys, you will need to download the new intermediate certificates (linked below) to use during the attestation flow.

Note that the Yubico CA root certificates have not changed, and the existing intermediate certificates (which are still part of the Yubico Intermediate Certificates file) are still valid. The new intermediate certificates were simply added to the file.
